

# **Seguin Art League Paint Out and Wet Painting Sale**

# Oct 23th - 24th, 2020 in Downtown Seguin, TX

**Paint Out:** Artists will meet at 104 S. Austin Street, downtown Seguin at 8:30 a.m. on Friday, Oct. 23rd. Artist's canvas, board or paper will be stamped on the back. Each artist will receive a participant's tag, map of the downtown area and tips on locations. Choose your location. The theme is "Anything Seguin". All painting media are acceptable, including pastel, pen and ink, and pencil. Artwork must be turned in by 5:00 p.m. Friday at 104 S. Austin St. Judging will take place the next day.

**Wet Painting Sale:** The sale setup will be at 9:30 a.m. Saturday at the Seguin Art League building, 104 S. Austin St. Sale hours are 10:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Work will be displayed on wire grids. Artists are invited to pass out ballots for "People's Choice" and discuss their paintings with the viewing public. <u>Masks and distancing will be required</u>. Votes will be collected and counted by SAL at 2:30 p.m. and the Peoples Choice winner and 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places will be announced at 3:30 p.m.

<u>Application process and fees:</u> Forms will be available at our website <u>www.seguinartleague.com</u>, or can be requested by email from fleurromero@gmail.com. <u>Application deadline is Oct. 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019 (postmark).</u> Mail your entry fee of \$25 for non-members, \$20 for members, or \$15 for students, to: Seguin Art League, P.O. Box 445, Seguin, TX 78156.

**Eligibility:** Event is open to all ages, <u>16 and above</u>.

**Awards**: 1st Prize = \$75. | 2nd Prize = \$50. | 3rd Prize = \$30. | People's Choice \$30. Gift certificate to "You're so Crafty"

**Judging process:** Qualified Judge on Oct. 23<sup>rd</sup>, "Peoples' Choice" by written ballot on Saturday Oct. 24th

### Rules: Canvas, board, or paper, must be:

- 1. A minimum 8"x 10" and no larger than 16" x 20"
- 2. Stamped at registration entry Friday, Oct. 23rd
- 3. All artwork must be done outdoors, at your chosen location. We will be taking photographs.
- 4. Art on canvas, board or in frames MUST BE wired and ready to hang BEFORE painting

  Art on paper must be matted and sleeved or framed and wired by 9:30 a.m. Saturday Oct. 24<sup>th</sup>
- 5. Dropped off at 104 S. Austin St. by 5:00 p.m. Friday, Oct. 23rd.\*
- **6.** Participating artists must display participant's tag during event
  - \*All on-location artwork must be available for sale at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, Oct 24th at 104 S. Austin St.
  - \*Seguin Art League's commission is 25% of sales
