You must leave your work in the gallery for the entire length of the show. All work must be for sale. SAL retains a 25% commission on all sales.

LIABILITY: Although the Seguin Art League will exercise due care in handling works submitted, the Seguin Art League, including any member acting on its behalf, is NOT responsible for any loss or damage to any work of art.
